Concentration/Relocation Camps Responsibilities

You are responsible for researching at least two Nazi Concentration Camps from the list below, two Japanese Interment camps, and one camp of your choosing making sure that your virtual museum addresses (answers and provides accurate information) the following questions:

- 1. What is the name of your camp? Where is it located? What years were it in operation?
- 2. What type of camp was it (Labor Camp, Transit/Collection Camp, POW Camp, and Camp for the Rehabilitation/ Reeducation of Poles, Hostage [Death] Camps, Extermination Camps, and Interment Camps)? What is the difference?
- 3. Who did the camp target? What methods did Nazis use to dehumanize their victims? What methods did Americans use to dehumanize their victims? What methods did the Japanese use to dehumanize their victims? Think about camp life, laws, propaganda, and any other components.
- 4. Describe the conditions of the camps including how people were processed into the camp system.
- 5. What was the daily routine of the prisoners like?
- 6. How many people were imprisoned in the camp? How many died? How did they die, i.e. what methods did the camp use to kill the dead? How many survived?
- 7. Why were children, senior citizens, and the sick killed?
- 8. Describe life for children.
- 9. Describe the hierarchy of the concentration camp.
- 10. What experiments were performed on prisoners of the death camp?
- 11. What evidence of crimes against humanity did Allied forces discover when they first entered the concentration camps?
- 12. Define the concept of genocide. Discuss examples of genocide over the history of mankind to the present. Choose one example of genocide and discuss.
- 13. What types of activities were there for the prisoners? (Education, music, sports, other arts.)
- 14. How did the prisoners get to the camps? (Deportation, transportation, centers
